Instructions

propane stove



NOTE: It is recommended that you use a long grill lighter to avoid contact with hands. Always use in a well-ventilated area – OUTDOORS IS PREFERRED!

- 1 Install propane tank.
- 2 Be sure all knobs on the stove are in the OFF position.
- 3 Open propane valve.
- 4 Open oven door and remove the bottom panel to light the pilot.
- 5 Push red button near the bottom/front and hold while lighting the pilot (inside the oven).
- 6 Once the pilot is lit, continue to hold in the red button for approximately 30-40 seconds.
- 7 Release the button, if the pilot did not light, repeat steps 5 and 6.
- 8 With the pilot lit, replace the bottom panel and close the oven door.
- 9 Proceed to light the center of each burner.
- 10 Stove will then be ready to use. Adjust flames to desired heat for cooking.
